



SASKATCHEWAN ARTS AWARDS – 2016

AWARDS INFORMATION

Nominations Closing Date: June 30, 2016 – 4:30 p.m.

Lieutenant Governor's Lifetime Achievement Award

Recognizes and celebrates an individual, group or collective engaged in the arts in Saskatchewan who:

- Is recognized as an established professional in their field who has reached an advanced level of accomplishment
- Has produced a substantive, cumulative and prominent body of work or has a history of continued contribution to the arts over a number of years, and has had a particularly significant impact on the arts in Saskatchewan through distinguished lifelong career achievements
- Has attained critical recognition nationally and internationally for an art practice and/or outstanding sustained and progressive contribution to the arts.

Award: \$10,000 and a limited edition award.

Assessors consider:

1. Artistic Merit
The nominee's acclaimed body of work; substantive, cumulative and prominent artistic achievements or continued contribution to the arts over a long and notable career; and critical recognition nationally and internationally for accomplishments and contributions to an art practice and/or the arts.
2. Relevance
The nomination and the nominee's accomplishments align with the stated purpose of the Lieutenant Governor's Lifetime Achievement Award.
3. Impact and Legacy
The nominee has made an outstanding sustained and progressive contribution to, and had a particularly significant impact on the arts in Saskatchewan through distinguished lifelong career achievements.

Awards for Artists

Artistic Excellence Award

Recognizes and celebrates an established professional¹ Saskatchewan artist, group or collective working in any art form who:

- Is at an advanced stage in their career
- Has created an extensive independent body of work and is making a sustained and progressive contribution to the art form
- Has attained significant critical recognition nationally and perhaps internationally and has had an important impact on the arts in Saskatchewan through publication and/or public presentation of their work.
- The award may be given based on a significant accomplishment in a single year or on the artist's cumulative body of work.

Award: \$6,000 and a limited edition award.

¹ Professional artists have completed basic training in their discipline (formal training or mentorships, as appropriate), have a body of work that has received critical recognition and are recognized as professionals by their peers.

Artistic Excellence Award *(continued)*

Assessors consider:

1. Artistic Merit
The nominee's resume; creation of an extensive independent body of work; critical recognition nationally and perhaps internationally; and achievements relative to their status as an established professional artist at an advanced stage in their career. The award may be given based on a significant accomplishment in a single year or on the artist's cumulative body of work.
2. Relevance
The nomination and the nominee's accomplishments align with the stated purpose of the Artistic Excellence Award.
3. Impact
The nominee is making a sustained and progressive contribution to the art form, and has had an important impact on the arts in Saskatchewan through publication and/or public presentation of their work.

Emerging Artist Award

Recognizes and celebrates an emerging professional¹ Saskatchewan artist, group or collective working in any art form who demonstrates exceptional promise through early notable accomplishments and who:

- Is in the early stage of their career
- Has created an independent body of work, and is making a continuing and progressive contribution to the art form
- Has received regional and perhaps national recognition and has had an impact on the arts in Saskatchewan through publication and/or public presentation of their work.

Award: \$6,000 and a limited edition award.

Assessors consider:

1. Artistic Merit
The nominee's resume; creation of an independent body of work; regional and perhaps national recognition through publication and/or presentation of their work; and level of achievement relative to their status as an emerging professional artist.
2. Relevance
The nomination and the nominee's accomplishments align with the stated purpose of the Emerging Artist Award.
3. Impact
The nominee's notable accomplishments, artistic practice and body of work have had a positive impact on their career and the arts in Saskatchewan.

Awards for Leadership

Leadership Award – Individual

Recognizes and celebrates an individual engaged in the arts in Saskatchewan who demonstrates outstanding leadership and commitment to the advancement of the arts and artists in the province through exemplary management, presentation, production, distribution, marketing, research, collection or curatorial practice.

For the Leadership Award – Individual, "individual" also can include two people who work together as one team.

Award: \$6,000 and a limited edition award.

Assessors consider:

1. Development of the Arts
The nominee's work in advancing the arts and/or artists in Saskatchewan by means of exemplary management, presentation, production, distribution, marketing, research, collection or curatorial practice.

Leadership Award – Individual *(continued)*

Assessors consider *(continued)*:

2. Relevance
The nomination and the nominee's accomplishments align with the stated purpose of the Leadership Award for individuals.
3. Impact and Effectiveness
The nominee's leadership, commitment and work have been effective and have had a positive and significant impact on the advancement of, and development of an appreciation and understanding of the arts and artists in Saskatchewan.

Leadership Award – Organization

Recognizes and celebrates an organization engaged in the arts in Saskatchewan that demonstrates outstanding leadership and commitment to the advancement, presentation and promotion of the arts and artists through exemplary programming, governance, operations, administration and/or innovation.

Award: \$6,000 and a limited edition award.

Assessors consider:

1. Development of the Arts
The nominee's work in advancing, presenting and promoting the arts and/or artists in Saskatchewan by means of exemplary programming, governance, operations, administration and innovation.
2. Relevance
The nomination and the nominee's accomplishments align with the stated purpose of the Leadership Award for organizations.
3. Impact and Effectiveness
The nominee's leadership, commitment and work have been effective and have had a positive and significant impact on the advancement of, and development of an appreciation and understanding of the arts and artists in Saskatchewan.

Award for Arts Educators

Arts and Learning Award

Recognizes and celebrates a Saskatchewan educator who has demonstrated outstanding commitment to the arts and learning by means of:

- Innovative approaches to education in the arts through exemplary programs, instruction, an art practice, or partnerships with artists or arts organizations that foster the creative and intellectual development of young people through education and experiences in the arts and
- The engagement of students in the exploration of contemporary artistic ideas or creative experiences that stimulate their understanding of the arts.

The award may be for career-long accomplishments or for a particularly innovative project.

For the Arts and Learning Award, "a Saskatchewan educator" also can include two educators who work together as one team.

Award: \$6,000 and a limited edition award.

Assessors consider:

1. Artistic Merit
The nominee has:
 - Developed and/or presented high-quality artistic programming that fosters the creative and intellectual development of young people through exploration of contemporary artistic ideas and/or creative experiences
 - Demonstrated a commitment to the importance of the arts in learning through innovative approaches, instruction, creative partnerships with artists or arts organizations, and/or an art practice.

Arts and Learning Award *(continued)*

Assessors consider *(continued)*:

2. Relevance
The nomination and the nominee's accomplishments align with the stated purpose of the Arts and Learning Award.
3. Impact
The nominee's work, achievements and/or artistic practice have had a positive and significant impact on students, school(s) and/or the community.

Award for Volunteers

Volunteer Award

Recognizes and celebrates a Saskatchewan resident who has demonstrated exceptional commitment to the arts by volunteering and dedicating their time and energy to one or more arts organizations. In doing so they have contributed substantially to enriching the arts and the cultural life of their community and the province.

For the Volunteer Award, "a Saskatchewan resident" also can include two people who work together as one team.

Award: To the volunteer – limited edition award.
To the volunteer's identified organization – \$6,000.

Assessors consider:

1. Volunteer Service
The nominee's volunteer and community service and dedication of their time and energy to one or more arts organizations.
2. Relevance
The nomination and the nominee's accomplishments align with the stated purpose of the Arts Volunteer Award.
3. Impact
The nominee's commitment and service have had a meaningful and substantial impact on the enrichment of the arts and the cultural life of their community and the province.

NOMINATION INFORMATION

Nominations Closing Date: June 30, 2016 – 4:30 p.m.

Confidentiality of Information

The personal and confidential information that a nominator and a nominee provide is collected, used and disclosed in accordance with the provisions of the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act and the Personal Information Protection and Electronic Documents Act. This information is required to process the nomination. The personal and confidential information of the nominator and the nominee will only be disclosed as necessary to employees of the Saskatchewan Arts Board and the adjudicators. The Saskatchewan Arts Board will respond to any inquiries regarding the privacy policies and procedures, including requests to access the applicant's personal information.

If selected for an award, the recipient's name, community and amount of the award will be made known publicly. The Saskatchewan Arts Board is required to report to the public on the funds it disburses through its programs.

Eligibility

- No individual, group, collective or organization will be selected for more than one award within any given year.
- Nominees may receive each award once only.
- The Saskatchewan Arts Awards were previously the Lieutenant Governor's Arts Awards. A list of those recipients is available on the Saskatchewan Arts Board's website www.saskartsboard.ca/awards.

Eligible Nominators

- **Individuals** who are Saskatchewan residents, live and maintain a permanent physical address in the province, and are Canadian citizens or Permanent Residents of Canada. Proof of residence may be requested¹.
- **Organizations** that are located in and have their permanent headquarters in Saskatchewan, and have a significant portion of their activity taking place in the province.

Eligible Nominees

- **Individuals:**
 - Saskatchewan residents who:
 - Are Canadian citizens or Permanent Residents of Canada,
 - Live and maintain a permanent physical address in the province, and
 - Have lived in Saskatchewan for a minimum of one year prior to the date of nomination and live in the province for at least six months in a year.

Individuals who meet the criteria for Saskatchewan residency as described above may be eligible while they are temporarily absent from the province for an arts education or artistic opportunity (e.g., artist in residence). The absence must be for no more two years and not be recurring. The individual must maintain their permanent physical address in Saskatchewan, must intend to return to the province at the end of the term and cannot receive funding from the jurisdiction of their temporary residence.

Proof of residence may be requested¹.

¹ Proof of residency is not required as part of the nomination but must be available on request. If requested, nominators and/or nominees must be able to provide three or more documents that verify residency status. Documentation may include, but is not limited to, a valid Saskatchewan Health Services card, a valid Saskatchewan Driver's License, evidence of income taxes paid in the previous year as a Saskatchewan resident and/or other documentation that verifies Saskatchewan residency.

Eligibility *(continued)*

Eligible Nominees *(continued)*

- **Groups and Collectives:**
Groups and collectives whose members meet the criteria for Saskatchewan residency described above under “Individuals”.
Proof of residence may be requested¹.
- **Organizations:**
Organizations that are located in and have their permanent headquarters in Saskatchewan, and are engaged in providing programs and/or services in the arts in the province.

Ineligible

- Self-nominations.
- Posthumous nominations.
- Nominations for an individual, group or collective from their family members or representatives (i.e. agents, managers, etc.).
- Nominations for an organization from its principals, Board members or employees.
- Nominations that do not include all required information and components, are not in the prescribed format, or are illegible or unsigned.
- Nominations delivered, postmarked, sent by courier or e-mailed after 4:30 p.m. on Thursday, June 30, 2016.

Selection of Award Recipients

- **Before nominations are assessed**, Saskatchewan Arts Board staff review them to confirm that eligibility and technical requirements have been satisfied.
- **The nomination submissions are assessed by an independent panel of assessors** with appropriate knowledge and experience assess through a competitive process based on the assessment criteria specific to the award categories. The panel establishes a short-list of nominees for each award and selects the recipient.
- The Saskatchewan Arts Board reserves the right to move a nomination to another award category if it or the assessment panel deems it more appropriate and/or to not allocate an award if the submitted nominations do not meet the criteria or if the panel chooses to not select a recipient for an award.

Nomination Requirements

IMPORTANT:

- **DO NOT staple, hole punch or clip nomination or support materials or place any items in page protectors, folders or binders.**
All nomination and support materials are scanned and provided to the adjudicators electronically.
- Nominators are strongly advised to consider the award’s assessment criteria when preparing their nomination package. The assessment criteria for each award are available in this package, beginning on page 2.
- The Saskatchewan Arts Board may contact the nominator at any time regarding any matter related to the nomination and/or to request additional information beyond that included in the nomination package.
