Recognize your funder:

- Display the Arts Board logo (www.saskartsboard.ca/logos) at events and on print materials. These include annual reports, newsletters, brochures, flyers, posters, programs, invitations, signs, and tickets. Logo display should be prominent and on par with the size of other sponsors' logos.

- Acknowledge Arts Board funding in speeches and presentations as well as at openings, performances and events.

If applicable, recognize funding from other funders:

- If you received a letter indicating that your activity is supported by Saskatchewan Lotteries funds through SaskCulture Inc., please see the attached brochure on how to acknowledge that support.
- If you received an Artists in Schools or Culture on the Go grant, please include the Government of Saskatchewan logo on your materials. This is also available on the logos page on our website.
